The third rotation of Phase – V Mid Career Training Programme (MCTP-Phase V) for IPS Officers of 24 to 26 years service is scheduled to commence at the Academy with effect from 09.04.2012. The Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad in tandem with The London Business School, London, UK is going to conduct the first three weeks at SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad from 09.04.2012 to 27.04.2012 followed by the last one week at London from 30.04.2012 to 05.05.2012.

2. According to the approved scheme of Mid-Career Training Programme, IPS Officers who are in the 24 to 26 years of service are eligible to undergo Phase V training. As per IPS (Pay) Rules, 2007, participation of IPS Officers in Phase V training programme would be an **essential requirement for their annual increment after 28 years.**

3. The maximum number of seats available in Phase V is 140. In order to fulfil the objective of optimal utilisation of the available seats, nominations are invited from IPS Officers of 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984, 1985, 1986 and 1987 batches (both RR & SPS officers) to attend the Phase V programme as above. The priority in selection of the officers will be made in the order of seniority.

4. You are requested to kindly nominate the IPS Officers of the above seniority (both RR & SPS Officers) for undergoing the Phase V training. The officers close to retirement are not to be nominated in accordance with the amended IPS (Pay) Rules, "a member of Service, who has less than three years of service after the year in which he has been slotted to undergo Phase V, of Mid-Carrer Training, would not be sent for mandatory mid-career training" and the same is notified on 20.09.2010 and intimated vide the NPA message No. 12011/9/2010-Trg (MCTP) dated 15.10.2010. **The nomination may please be sent to SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad by 01.03.2012.** The Academy will communicate the names of IPS Officers selected for participation in the Phase V programme by 10.03.2012. The NPA will communicate with the selected officers individually regarding further details of the programme like course curriculum, reading material etc. Hence, while nominating the names of IPS Officers, you are requested to intimate their complete contact address with telephone/fax/e-mail ID. Regarding IPS Officers of the above seven batches on **deputation**, the concerned Directors/DsG of CPOs/CAPFs/Departments may kindly be intimated immediately for nominating them.

5. It has been observed in the past that some officers, despite being nominated for the MCTP could not be relieved by their organisations due to exigencies of work and the State Governments then requested for further relaxation from the provisions of mandatory training. The matter was considered in the M.H.A. and the Competent Authority approved vide MHA letter No. 16011/15/2004-IPS.II dated 27.08.2010 one time relaxation to the IPS Officers for Phase V and directed that **IPS Officers of 1981, 1982, 1983 and 1984 Batches may be allowed to draw increments after 28 years of service, provided they complete Phase V by end of 2012 and no further relaxation beyond the above period in respect of the Officers of the aforesaid batches will be allowed.** Further, only those officers may be nominated who would be spared by you and once their nomination is accepted, subsequent withdrawal of nomination must be avoided.

6. The travel expenses of the nominated officers towards their to and fro journey to NPA are to be borne by the concerned State Governments/CAPFs. During their training at the NPA, the officers will be given free boarding and lodging, and accordingly their TA may be regularised as per the rules on the subject. As regards their Exposure Visit of one week to London, the **Academy will bear their to and fro air fare from Hyderabad and expenditure on accommodation and per diem** during their stay in London.

7. In view of above I would request you to kindly send the nominations of the eligible IPS Officers (both RR and SPS officers) of the indicated seven batches to SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad latest by 01.03.2012, so that we may have sufficient time to obtain their political clearance from Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), on the basis of which the nominated officers will then be required to get their Official (White) Passports issued from their respective passport offices as also their Visas from the UK Embassy for their foreign visit.
