The Reunion Seminar of 2001 Batch (54RR) of IPS Officers is scheduled to be held at the Academy on 19th -20th January, 2026.

2. Eligibility: -

- a. All IPS Officers of 2001 Batch and from any other batch, who were trained with 54 RR, are eligible to participate in the Seminar.
- b. IPS officers who were allotted 2001 Batch but not trained with 54 RR are not eligible to participate in the Seminar. Such officers may be nominated for the Re-Union Seminar being conducted for that RR in which they were trained.

- 3. The objective of the Seminar is to utilize the expertise of the Senior Officers, who have put in 25 years of Service, on specific aspects of Policing as well as to provide an opportunity for Officers of the batch to meet and exchange their varied field experience.
- 4. The theme of the Seminar is "From Investigation to Policy: Crafting a unified National strategy against organized crime". The participants may be requested to send a write up of 2-3 pages on the theme of the Seminar to the Academy in advance, which will be consolidated and distributed among the Participants.

The IPS Officers of 2001 Batch (54 RR), who are presently on deputation to other Organizations, voluntarily retired/superannuated from service may please be informed about the dates of the Reunion Seminar, under intimation to the Academy.
