 - c. Apps/ tools used in Citizen Centric Services.
 - d. Apps/ tools used in operations/ tactics/ intelligence
 - e. Apps/ tools used in Law-and-Order work and in detection of crimes.
 - f. Apps/ tools used for traffic Management.
 - g. Apps/ tools used for dealing with immigration/ foreigners.
- v. Once the workshop is over, all the learnings from the workshop will be complied and shared with States/ UTs/ CPOs/ CAPFs.
- vi. All the expenditure on setting up stalls will be borne by the Academy.
