A 5-days course on " Skill Development for Effective Handling of Explosives/ IEDs Related Threats & Exposures to Latest Trends/ Techniques in IED & PBP" is scheduled to be held at SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad from 21<sup>st</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2026 for the IPS officers of the rank of ASP to SSP [2021 and senior only], Dy. SP to SSP from State Police services, AC/DC/2IC/ Commandant/ Senior Commandant from CAPFs and equivalent ranks from CPOs with minimum 3 years of service.

2. **The primary objectives of the Course are to make participants conversant with: -**
  - The basics of Explosives, Classification, its effect, initiation, and identification.
  - Detection and Disposal techniques.
  - Render safe procedures, categorization of bomb threats, and adopt appropriate counter measure.
3. **Participants Level: -**
  - ❖ IPS officers of the rank of ASP to SSP [2021 and senior only]

- ❖ State Police Service officer of the rank of Dy. SP to SSP
- ❖ Officers from CAPFs/CPOs/ any other organization of equivalent rank.


7. The dress order for the participants is as follows: -
