- iv. Keywords: Include a set of relevant keywords that best describe the content of your submission.
- v. Author Information: A brief biography of 100-200 words about the author(s) should be included.
- vi. Format: Submissions should be in MS Word format.
- vii. Honorarium: An honorarium of ₹5000 will be paid for selected articles, and ₹1500 for selected book reviews.

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(B) Submission Process:

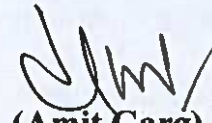
- Please send the contributions via email to npajournal@svpnpa.gov.in.
