- v. Author Information: A brief biography of 100-200 words about the author(s) should be included.
- vi. Format: Submissions should be in MS Word format.
- vii. Honorarium: An honorarium of ₹5000 will be paid for selected articles, and ₹1500 for selected book reviews.

- The deadline for submissions is 15th of December, 2025.
- All submissions will undergo a peer-review process, and authors of selected contributions will be notified by 31st of December, 2025.
