

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Training syllabus and study material provided to IPS probationers at SVPNPA?

- The IPS Probationers are provided with Indoor & Outdoor Handbook which is approved by the Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi.

2. Current and upcoming vacancies to be filled by SVPNPA such as LDC, MTS, Stenographer etc.?

- Information is provided based on the actual data of the Academy at that time.

3. Marks obtained by the IPS probationer as per the rules for probationer assessment or in Civil Services Examination?

- If the requisition is asked by an affected officer his information is provided. Third party information is exempted under Section 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005.

4. Personal details such as parents name, home address of IPS Probationers of specific batches allotted to particular cadre and trained at SVP NPA?

- Third party information is exempted under Section 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005.

5. Attendance rules applicable to IPS probationers during training, especially for examinations, official tours, and classroom sessions?

- Details are mentioned in Basic Course Indoor Training Handbook, which contains the details of attendance rules and leave policy.

6. List of IPS probationers who undertook training in SVPNPA over a defined period?

- List is being provided after due concurrence of the competent authority.

- Requisition through an email or through post may be sent. Decision of the competent authority will be the final.

13. What posts are available in SVPNPA through direct recruitment, deputation, absorption or short-term contract?

- The updated list of sanctioned posts, vacancies and mode of recruitment is published through vacancy circulars, recruitment notifications and departmental orders issued from time to time.

14. Which posts are entitled to Training Allowance and Sumptuary Allowance?

- Training Allowance and Sumptuary Allowance are regulated by Government of India instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance, Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT), Ministry of Home Affairs and other competent authorities. The list of eligible posts is maintained by the Administration and Accounts Sections.

15. Can deputation be granted without completing the cooling-off period?

- Exemptions, where permissible, may be granted only by the competent authority in accordance with applicable Government of India instructions.

16. Which posts are classified as faculty positions?

- Faculty classification is determined by the approved organizational structure and relevant Recruitment Rules.

17. What salary advances and allowances are admissible to IPS Officer Trainees?

- Salary advances, stipend components and admissible allowances are regulated by Government of India orders applicable to IPS Probationers.

18. What subjects are taught to IPS trainees?

- The training curriculum includes law, police leadership, investigation, internal security, criminology, forensics, cybercrime, intelligence, physical training, weapons training and other professional subjects.

19. What is the duration and structure of IPS training?

- IPS training is conducted in phases comprising institutional training, district practical training and specialized modules as prescribed by the Academy.

20. How many trainees failed or reappeared in assessments during the last five years?

- Such information is maintained in training records and may be provided subject to availability and applicable disclosure provisions.

21. What vacancies exist in Group A, B, C and D posts under MHA and its organizations?

- Vacancy positions are maintained separately by each organization and are subject to periodic revision.

22. What are the category-wise vacancy details for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/UR?

- Reservation rosters and vacancy data are maintained according to Government of India reservation policies.

23. Where can recruitment notifications be accessed?

- Recruitment notifications are published on the official websites of the concerned organizations and in official employment notices.

24. Can caste certificates, medical records or personal service records of individual officers be disclosed?

- Personal information relating to an identifiable individual, including caste certificates, medical records and personal documents, is generally exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act, 2005 unless a larger public interest justifies disclosure.
