Sub: A Two-Week Course on 'Tactics' is scheduled to be held in the S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from 01st - 12th December, 2025 - Inviting Nominations – Reg.

Madam/Sir,

A two weeks Course on 'Tactics' is scheduled to be held at SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad from  $01^{st}$  - $12^{th}$  December, 2025 for Dy. SP to SP from States and ACs & DCs from CAPFs/CPOs.

#### 2. The course on Tactics is a two-week duration comprising the following modules:

- a. Jungle Module
- b. Urban Module
- c. Module on Explosives

#### 3. The primary objective of the course is to make the participants: -

- a. Conversant with the conduct of tactical operations in militancy infested areas including urban, rural and jungle areas.
- b. Conversant with the minor tactics and basic drills of CI Ops.
- c. Conversant with use of geographical area and weapons to their tactical advantage.
- d. Aware about latest technologies in terms of weapons including non-lethal options, communication equipment and body wear/armor, to sustain prolonged operations.
- e. Aware about importance of engaging with the community in insurgency/naxalism prone areas for success of CI Ops.

### 4. Participation Level: -

- a. Directly recruited IPS officers (ASP& SP) with minimum 3 years of service.
- b. Directly recruited Dy. SP & Addl. SP from States with minimum 3 years of service.
- c. Directly recruited officers (AC&DC) from CAPFs/CPOs with minimum 3 years of service.
- d. Promoted State service officers can also be nominated if they are willing and physically fit and are serving with any special task forces.
- 5. **Eligibility:** Since this course involves outdoor exercise in the Jungle, the participants nominated for this course should be physically fit and preferably below 40 years of age. The maximum age limit for nomination is 45 years subject to willingness and physical fitness of the nominee. The officers nominated for the course are advised to undergo morning jog/brisk walk for 1-2 kms per day for 10 days prior to the course to prepare themselves to undertake 5 to 8 kms of tactical move in the jungle.
- 6. **Nomination:** Each State /CAPFs/Organization have been allotted 04 seats. Hence, it is requested to nominate four officers for the said course as main and one more as reserve, well in advance, with following details of their cadre, full address including fax/telephone numbers and e-mail address. Reserve Officers are to be kept ready for last moment replacement.

- 8. The Programme is fully residential and the participants of the Course will be staying in the accommodation provided by the Academy. The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy, in respect of all officers attending the Course. However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the respective State / Central Government Departments. It is informed that as per SOP of the Academy, those Officers against whom any criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are not eligible to undergo any training programme/course/seminar at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible Officers may only be sent accordingly.
- 9. The dress order for the participants is as follows:

**Indoor**: is Civvies i.e. shirt (full sleeves). Trouser. tie & formal shoes for gentlemen and Salwar Kameez/Saree/Business Suit for ladies.

**Outdoor**: Camouflage dungarees including cap, Jungle Shoes & belt or Lower Camouflage dungarees with Gray/Green T-Shirt & Jungles shoes.

10. The nominees may be advised to proceed for the programme only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy. The

officers nominated for the course are required to report at the Academy by the **evening** of 30th November, 2025 i.e. one day before the commencement of the course. Transport from Hyderabad Airport / Railway station to the Academy and back will be provided by the Academy as per travel plan provided by the participants. Families are not allowed during the course. Participants may also note that drivers/orderlies/PSOs/maids are not allowed inside the campus.
