A 5- day Course on “**Anti -Terror Intelligence, Investigation Operations**” conducted by the National Investigation Agency, New Delhi, scheduled to be held at the

S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad form 07th – 11th September, 2026 for the officers of the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police.

2. **The objective of the Course is to facilitate learning in:**

- i. Enhanced Strategic Understanding of Terrorism, evolving terrorism landscape, threats, and contemporary counter-terrorism challenges.
- ii. Understanding Counter-Terrorism Policy & Strategy in different theatres.
- iii. Tactical & Operational Preparedness & to raise a Counter- Terror Force to deal effectively with Terrorist Organizations and its ecosystem.
- iv. Improved Investigative Competence of Law Enforcement Agencies.
- v. Supervision of investigation of cases, prosecution, and trial management in terrorism-related cases, important judicial pronouncements.
- vi. Legal and Institutional Proficiency, a thorough understanding of the provisions of the NIA Act, the UAPA, and the institutional framework for combating terrorism.
- vii. Enhancement of Operational Capability, skills, planning and executing counter-terrorism operations by Law Enforcement Agencies.
- viii. Identifying & dismantling terrorist networks, and applying lessons learned from significant case studies in various theatres.
- ix. **International Cooperation**, Understanding of terror financing investigations, the role of FIU, and international cooperation through Letters Rogatory (LR), Mutual Legal Assistance Treaties (MLAT), and extradition mechanisms.
- x. For better Inter-Agency Coordination, the best practices followed among ATS, STF, NIA, and other stakeholder agencies for an effective and integrated response to terrorism.
- xi. Use of technology and harnessing big data.

The Course is fully residential and the participants of the Course will be staying in the accommodation provided by the Academy. **The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy.** However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the Course may be borne by the respective State / Central Government Departments. It is informed that as per SOP of the Academy, those Officers against whom any criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are **not eligible** to undergo any training programme/course/seminar/workshop at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible Officers may only be sent accordingly.

7. **The nominees may be advised to proceed for the course only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy.** The Officers nominated for the Course are required to report at the Academy by the **evening of 06th September, 2026** i.e., one day before the commencement of the course. Transport from Hyderabad Airport / Railway Station to Academy and back will be provided by the Academy as per travel plan provided by the participants.
