Sub: A 05-day Course on 'Coordination among Police Department, Prison, Judiciary, Prosecutors and FSL' will be organized by the S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from 18-22 May, 2026 - Inviting nominations – Reg.

Madam/Sir,

A 05-day Course on '**Coordination among Police Department, Prison, Judiciary, Prosecutors and FSL**' is being organized by S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from **18 - 22 May, 2026** for Officers of the rank of Addl. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police and also for officers of equivalent ranks from Judiciary, FSL, Prison Department and Prosecution officers.

2. The objectives of the Course are:-

- a. To strengthen the capacity of all stake holders of CJS by identifying gaps and issues in co-ordination.
- b. Discuss/Brainstorm on proactive and innovative measures/case studies to improve co-ordination.
- c. Awareness of problems and issues faced by each other (agencies)
- d. General expectations from each other.
- e. Discuss required amendments in Substantive and Procedural Criminal laws for effective coordination among agencies.
- f. To discuss the required amendments for making procedural and substantive laws more simpler and speedy justice oriented, especially in the light of suggestions sought by Ministry of Home Affairs, from all the States, regarding amendments in Criminal Statutes.
- g. To encourage widespread awareness and understanding about the latest processes being incorporated in CIS system, integration of CIS and CCTNS and the latest initiatives being undertaken by E-Committee of Supreme Court.
- h. To apprise the officers of amendments required in procedural and substantive laws for making trials lesser cumbersome and speedy.
- i. To make Legal Aid, Plea Bargaining, Camp Courts, Alternative Dispute Resolutions a reality in criminal justice delivery system.
- j. Understanding the application of Pre-Trial Conference, splitting of trial, stages mandatorily requiring the presence of accused and where it can be dispensed with.
- k. Discussing the best practices being followed in other States for speedy disposal of cases.
- l. Learning the effectiveness of usage of provisions regarding withdrawal of cases by prosecution to reduce the pendency.

3. It is requested to nominate Three (03) eligible officers of the rank of Addl. SP to IG (**Main - 03 & Reserve-1**) from each State/UT/CPOs to attend the Course. Officers associated with trial monitoring should preferably be nominated. It is also requested to nominate three eligible officers from each State of the rank of **JMFC and above** from Judiciary, of the rank of **Scientific Officer and above** from State FSL and of the rank of Addl. SP and above from Prison Department & Prosecution Department, rank of the Senior Public Prosecutors, Deputy Director/Joint Director/Director of Prosecution for the course.

5. The Course is residential and the participants of the Course will be staying in the accommodation provided by the Academy. The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy. However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the Course may be borne by the respective state/Central Government Department. It is informed that as per SOP of the Academy, those officers against whom any criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are **not eligible** to undergo any training programme/course/seminar/workshop at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible officers may be sent accordingly.

6. The dress order for the Course participants is Civvies i.e. shirt (full sleeves), Trouser & tie for gentlemen and Salwar Kameez/Saree/Business suit for ladies.

7. The nominees may be advised to proceed for the Course only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy. The officers nominated for the Course are required to report at the Academy by the **evening of 17th May, 2026** i.e. one day before the commencement of the Course. Transport from Hyderabad Airport/railway station to the Academy and back will be provided by the Academy as per travel plan provided by the participants.
